**RE: SUSPENSION OF ALL ON-GOING PHYSICAL TEACHING AND LEARNING IN
ALL SCHOOLS EXCEPT SCHOOL OF MEDICINE AND SCHOOL OF NURSING**

This is to inform you that all ongoing physical teaching and learning in all schools except in the School of Medicine and School of Nursing have been suspended with immediate effect till further notice. This is in compliance with directive number 13 (xiii) of the 15th Presidential Executive Order of Friday, 26th March, 2021, on COVID-19 pandemic that states:

'With respect to Education in Kenya, there shall be the immediate **suspension of all on-going physical learning** in all our education institutions including universities and tertiary and vocations colleges, other than for candidates sitting for their examinations and those in medical training institutions, until otherwise notified.'

You are directed to leave the University premises by Sunday 28th March 2021 at noon. The University shall, in due course communicate to you Senate decisions on arrangements for teaching and learning. Further, new schedules for examinations that were planned to start on 6th April 2021 shall be communicated to affected students.

We advise all students to at all times observe the Ministry of Health guidelines and directives on COVID-19 Pandemic containment.
