Maseno University School of Medicine invites qualified applicants for admission into the following postgraduate programmes for the 2026 academic year. The programmes are designed to equip graduates with advanced knowledge, research capacity, and professional competencies in their respective disciplines.

Application Deadline: Monday, 29th June 2026 at 5:00 PM

Master of Medicine in Family and Emergency Medicine

A four-year full-time residential programme aimed at training specialists in Family Medicine and Emergency Medicine with competencies in comprehensive patient care, emergency response, and community-oriented healthcare.

Master of Medicine in Obstetrics and Gynaecology

A four-year full-time residential programme focusing on women's reproductive health, obstetric care, surgical skills, and advanced management of gynaecological conditions.

Master of Medicine in Internal Medicine

A four-year full-time residential programme designed to develop specialists in adult medicine with strong clinical, diagnostic, and research skills.

Master of Medicine in Paediatrics and Child Health

A four-year full-time residential programme aimed at producing specialists in child health, neonatal care, and paediatric disease management.

Master of Medicine in General Surgery

A five-year full-time residential programme focusing on surgical principles, operative skills, perioperative care, trauma management, and specialist surgical practice.

Master of Science in Medical Physiology

A two-year full-time residential programme focusing on advanced understanding of human physiological processes, biomedical research, and academic development in physiology.

PhD in Medical Physiology

A three-year full-time residential programme emphasizing advanced research, innovation, and scientific contribution in medical physiology.

Master of Science in Human Anatomy

A two-year full-time residential programme focusing on gross anatomy, histology, embryology, and anatomical sciences research.

PhD in Human Anatomy

A three-year full-time residential programme designed to advance research and scholarship in anatomical sciences.

Master of Science in Infectious Diseases

A two-year full-time residential programme focusing on infectious disease epidemiology, diagnostics, prevention, treatment, and public health response.

General Admission Requirements

- Applicants must possess qualifications relevant to the programme applied for from a recognized institution.
- Applicants for clinical programmes must have completed internship and possess valid professional registration where applicable.
- Applicants must provide certified academic and professional documents.
- Applicants should demonstrate proficiency in English.
- Applicants must submit completed application forms together with all required supporting documents.
