RE: FEES PAYMENT REQUIREMENTS FOR THE 2026/2027 ACADEMIC YEAR

All students are urged to take note of the following requirements and comply as appropriate:

I. Clearance of Outstanding Arrears from Previous Academic Years

All continuing students with outstanding arrears on the Household Component from previous academic years are required to clear the said arrears in full before they can be allowed to undertake semester and course registration. Students will not be permitted to register for units until this requirement has been satisfied. Only students who have registered for the semester will be allowed to sit for Continuous Assessment Tests (CATs).

II. Semester Household Fees

Continuing students are required to pay the same semester household fees that were applicable during the 2025/2026 Academic Year. No change has been made to this fee for continuing students.

III. Extension of Government Funding Application Window for First-Time Applicants

The window for eligible first-time applicants to apply for government funding has been extended to **21st September 2026**. Any student who fails to apply for government funding within this period will be required to meet the full cost of the programme entirely.

All fee payments **MUST** be processed through the student portal. Any student with queries regarding their fees statement or account balance should visit the Student Finance Office for clarification.
